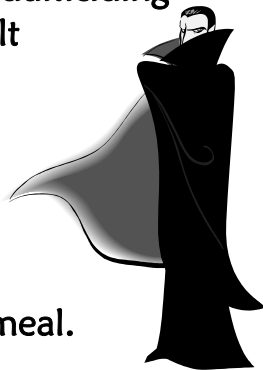


## Methods of Treatment

- ◆ **Larviciding:** This method of mosquito control is used to treat areas of standing water that are the breeding grounds for mosquitoes. The goal of larviciding is to kill the mosquito larvae before they mature into adult mosquitoes.

**Adulticiding:** The most recognizable part of the mosquito control program. Adulticiding kills the adult mosquitoes flying from dusk until dawn in search of a blood meal.

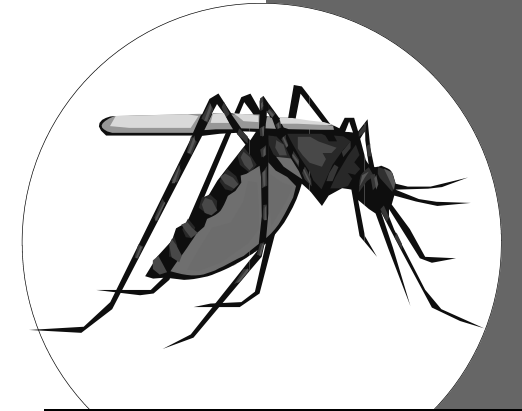

**A—**The Health Department sprays for mosquitoes because they can spread diseases such as:

- ◆ West Nile Virus
- ◆ La Crosse Encephalitis
- ◆ Eastern Equine Encephalitis
- ◆ St. Louis Encephalitis



Products used to Control Mosquitoes:

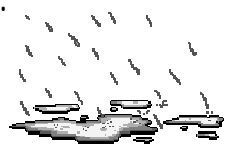
- ◆ Biomist Adulticide
- ◆ Abate 4E Larvacide
- ◆ Vectolex Larvacide



All of the products used during the mosquito control operation are applied by trained and licensed pest control applicators. These products are labeled for public application and applied according to EPA guidelines.

What you can do ...

- ◆ Get rid of standing water



- ◆ Empty birdbaths

- ◆ Clean clogged gutters

- ◆ Empty kiddie pools



- ◆ Get rid of old tires



*FACT: One tire can provide a breeding ground for 10,000 mosquitoes!*

- ◆ Wear light-colored clothing when out at peak mosquito times

- ◆ Avoid heavy perfumes

- ◆ Use mosquito repellants containing DEET according to label directions
