### Community Health Planning

The Healthier Muskingum County Network has formed from 50 agencies invested in the assessment of the Local Public Health System. This Network will review all of the community health assessment data in order to develop the Muskingum County Health Improvement Plan. The Board of Health completed the Local Public Health Governance Assessment.

### Healthy Homes Activities

The Healthy Homes and

Lead Poisoning Regional Support Program Grant was submitted. The Child Lead Surveillance Grant Personal Service Contract was approved to receive \$2,000 to coordinate a regional conference in Athens. The Healthy Home Case Manager Memo of Understanding was approved to do environmental physical assessments in homes.

### School Health Promotion Activities

The Child and Family Health Services (Childhood

Obesity/School Health) Grant was submitted. Every public school district and other educational organizations in Muskingum County were represented at the School Cooks' Conference.

### Tobacco Prevention Activities

The Tobacco Prevention Grant was submitted and approved. The grant focuses local efforts and resources on activities that have the potential to change local policies and systems related to tobacco.
