



## SE Ohio Regional Support Program Healthy Homes & Lead Poisoning Prevention



The Zanesville-Muskingum County Health Department is designated as the Regional Support Program for a 17-county region in southeast/southern Ohio. The Center maintains a full-time coordinator who is responsible for providing training, support and information about healthy homes and lead to medical providers, health departments, media outlets, social service agencies and clinics. In addition, a Healthy Homes Specialist is available to provide in-depth housing assessments and coordinate primary prevention, case management and lead risk assessments when the need is identified. The Regional Support Program is working in conjunction with the state to sustain a coordinated, comprehensive, and holistic approach to preventing diseases and injuries that result from housing-related hazards and deficiencies.

### Trainings:

**HHIP (Healthy Homes Introduction for Professionals)** is a 90 minute training that introduces some of the environmental hazards in the home that can negatively affect human health. Topics include: lead, mold, asthma triggers, carbon monoxide, radon, safety hazards, etc.

**Office Based PLANET (Pediatric Lead Assessment Network Educational Training)** is a brief training for physicians, providers and staff that is completed in their office. The training is generally less than 20 minutes.

### **Web PLANET (Pediatric Lead Assessment Network Educational Training)**

This training is offered on-line for healthcare providers who work closely with at-risk families. This 1-hour lead specific curriculum will update healthcare professionals about Ohio's Childhood Lead Poisoning screening recommendations, medical case management, and risk factors.
